



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

When will the SportsPlex open?

The facility is expected to open in late 2024 / early 2025.

What are the anticipated hours of operation?

September thru April:

Monday thru Sunday – 8:00 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. (no reservations after 9:00 p.m.)

May thru August:

Monday thru Saturday – 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. (no reservations after 7:00 p.m.)

Sunday – 1:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. (no reservations after 7:00 p.m.)

What can I do at the SportsPlex?

Flexibility is the name of our game! The SportsPlex offers a variety of amenities to keep users of all ages busy on any of our sports surfaces. Whether it be via rentals, activities, drop-in accessibility, youth and adult programming, or special event space, the opportunities are endless. Is there seating for spectators?

Yes, each designated space has a mix of fixed or flexible seating options. Within the gymnasium alone, there will be over 3,000 seats! Additionally, there will be seating along the turf area for spectators to view the action occurring on the fields.

When can I begin scheduling weekend special events or tournaments at the SportsPlex?

Will there be public drop-in availability?

Yes, there will be designated hours specifically for public drop-in/group play set each month. Each space will have public drop-in availability via two-hour increments. Times for public drop-in may vary monthly depending on other events scheduled in the facility. An admission fee is required to participate in public drop-in sessions.

Can I rent specific courts or surface space during the week (Monday thru Friday)?

Yes, outside of drop-in availability and assigned maintenance hours, all of the designated spaces will be available for hourly rentals (one hour is the minimum rental duration). An online calendar is coming soon that will assist users in viewing available times. Users can contact SportsPlex staff to make rental arrangements.

Will there be an admission charge to attend events or tournaments?

SportsPlex does not charge participant or spectator admissions. Instead, individual event organizer/s may elect to charge and collect their own event-based admission fees from participants or spectators.

What are the field and court dimensions?

Within the gymnasium, there are eight (8) high school regulation basketball courts, which can also be converted into 8/10/12 volleyball courts.

Each basketball court measures 84 feet long x 50 feet wide. Each volleyball court measures 59 feet long x 29 feet 6 inches wide. Four (4) divider curtains can divide the courts. The gymnasium also includes ghost markings for an additional 16 pickleball courts and 20/22 wrestling mats.

The turf field can be divided into three (3) fields accommodating U14, U12, and U10 soccer fields.

- U14 field dimensions: 330 feet long x 159 feet wide (110 yards x 53 yards)
- U12 field dimensions: 225 feet long x 159 feet wide (75 yards x 53 yards)
- U10 field dimensions: 159 feet long x 105 feet wide (53 yards x 35 yards)

There are three (3) 75 feet long x 15 feet wide batting cages available, in addition to baseball/softball infield area.
